In-Patient Chemotherapy Care: Safety Steps to Providing Quality Care

- Utilization and review of the implemented in-patient chemotherapy policy and routine reinforcement of these standard guidelines.
- 2. Train and educate all healthcare staff involved with the care and management of the chemotherapy by providing orientation, self learning modules.
- 3. Safely administer all antineoplastic agents by confirming these drugs with the pharmacy and 2 certified registered nurses.
- 4. Utilize the Chemotherapy Resource Nurse in IV Therapy and work as a team to collaborate care for the patient.
- 5. Coordinate all chemotherapies with the in-patient nurse, Pharmacy, and chemotherapy RN, prohibiting pregnant/breastfeeding nurses to be involved with care.
- 6. Utilize the Nursing Supervisor as a contact when the Outpatient IV Therapy Unit is closed.
- 7. Note all Cycle Day 2 timed medications and ensure these medications will be administered on time.
- 8. Obtain all appropriate equipment needed for chemotherapy administration and have these tools at the bedside.
- 9. Enforce chemotherapy precautions for the patient, nurse, and visitor.
- 10. Notify the Chemo Resource RN for discharge planning concerning patient medications, precautions, and support groups.
